

Referrals to Cancer Care Management

Medical oncology patient must have a confirmed diagnosis of cancer, **AND** have been notified of cancer diagnosis by their physician. (See also bullet 5.)

Primary reason for hospital stay must be symptoms of, treatment for, or complications from cancer/cancer treatment.

If a surgical patient is diagnosed or has consults for medical oncology and/or radiation oncology **BUT** the patient opts not to have treatment, this will be transferred to the medical team.

If patient is <u>currently</u> receiving chemotherapy or radiation as an outpatient and is admitted for any reason (related as well as unrelated complication).

Medical/Surgical patients with a pathology pending will be picked up if:

- 1. Medical Oncology and/or Radiation Oncology have been consulted and are establishing a treatment plan
- 2. The patient has been made aware of the diagnosis
