## Association of Community Cancer Centers Treasurer's Report to the Board of Trustees Financial Reports for December 2023 Douglas B. Flora, MD, LSSBB

## Variance Report

**Membership Renewals:** As of the end of December, 530 Cancer Program Members (or 84.4%) have renewed their membership and 114 Individual Members (or 51.8%) have renewed. The budget for the year has 590 Cancer Program Members renewing and 132 Individual Members.

**New Members**: There was 1 new Cancer Program Member and 3 new Individual Members added in December. The budget for the year includes 22 new Cancer Program Members and 90 new Individual Members.

**Investment Income:** The Morgan Stanley Investment account had interest and unrealized gains in December that totaled about \$86,074.60.

**Digital Assets/Website Revenue:** The negative variance of \$5,550 was caused by the timing difference: the invoices for advertising were generated and sent out but the payments have not been received yet.

**National Oncology Conf. (NOC) Revenue:** Revenue for the NOC (exhibit fees, attendee registrations, and sponsorships), as of December, was over budget by \$5,960. Additional revenue of \$31,000, from IAC companies' sponsorship and exhibit fees, will be recorded once their dues have been paid.

**Membership Expenses:** Expenses due to budgeted costs for re-branding design and printing are under budget in December by about \$15,041.29. This variance occurred due to timing: these costs are expected to occur later this year.

**Oncology Issues Expenses:** Oncology Issues expenses were above budget by \$9,175.00 in the month of December. Most of the variance is in Design, mostly due to a payment for layout and design of Oncology Issues magazine, volume 38, number 6.

**ACCC's Reserve Funds**: Some costs, including Labor and Consultant fees were recorded in December for Optic-Board Approved Project.

**Exhibits Expenses:** Exhibit expenses were above budget by \$6,657.96 in the month of December. The variance is due to exhibit fees and related travel expenses for various meetings, including ASH Annual Meeting, JADPRO, and ACE Annual Meeting.
