MFMBFRSHIP TYPFS/ANNUAL DUFS

Regular (\$150): Physician oncology specialists who are licensed by the State of Tennessee.

Group (5-50 physicians: \$2,500; more than 50 physicians: \$3,500): Physicians of a group practice or university who meet the requirements of Regular Membership qualify for Group Membership. All employees who meet the requirements of an Associate member are complimentary.

Associate (\$50): Allied health professionals, including registered nurses, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, pharmacists, cancer registrars, administrators, social workers or other healthcare professionals.

Fellow (complimentary): Any physician enrolled in an oncology or hematology subspecialty training program in Tennessee.

Retired (complimentary): Retired oncologists who are eligible for Regular Membership.
