#### MEMBERSHIP TYPES

**Physician (\$300 annually)**: Oncology or hematology physicians who are licensed to practice by the State of West Virginia or have a clinical interest and/or practice for patients with cancer. Dues include up to three allied health professionals. Additional Affiliate members or member physicians may join at \$25 each.

Group (\$1,200 annually per group of four or more physicians): Physicians in a hospital, academic, or group practice who meet Physician Membership requirements. May include up to 10 allied health professionals. Additional physicians who meet the requirements may join at \$150 each.

**Group - Additional Affiliates (\$25 annually)**: If a group is an ACCC Cancer Program Member, additional affiliates may be added at no charge.

**Affiliate (\$25 annually)**: Allied health professionals who do not join with Physician or Group members.

**Associate (complimentary)**: Physicians in fellowship training with a state specialty in hematology or oncology or who are in a training program with a clinical interest in patients with cancer.
