By participating in The Total Lung Care Program at Middlesex Hospital, you have taken an important step in becoming an active member of your healthcare team. Early detection is a valuable tool in identifying lung abnormalities. Early detection CT lung screening may detect cancers not visible on chest x-rays, at the time when these cancers are still in an early stage with a high probability of a cure.

The radiologist who interpreted the results of your exam has recommended that you make a follow-up appointment with your PCP to go over the results of the lung-screening test. Radiology recommended a CT in 3 months which will now be covered by insurance.
